# What is it?

The Temporary Scorebook (or “Score Record Book for Temporary Classification”) is a record of your scores and your running average used to determine your classification until you receive an official classification card from the NRA.

# How to use it

Let's assume your first NRA (approved or registered) tournament was one day of a Outdoor Conventional Prone tournament. Your score was a 1546 out of a possible 1600.

Take your score and divide it by the number of 10 shot strings:  $\frac{1546}{16} = 96.625$

Look-up your classification\* based on your average, for Outdoor Conventional Prone, Sharpshooter is from 96.50 to 98.49, so this score would place you in the Sharpshooter class.

# Subsequent Matches

Continuing the scenario: At your next Outdoor Conventional Prone tournament, your score was a 3095 out of a possible 3200.

Bring your previous totals forward, add your new scores, then do the division:

$$\frac{4641}{48} = 96.6875$$

Look-up your classification\* based on your running average. In this example, you are still in the Sharpshooter class.

# Different Classifications and their Scores

## Outdoor Conventional Prone

- Master 99.50 and above
- Expert 98.50 to 99.49
- Sharpshooter 96.50 to 98.49
- Marksman below 96.50

## Outdoor Metric Prone

- Master 94.50 and above
- Expert 92.00 to 94.49
- Sharpshooter 89.50 to 91.99
- Marksman below 89.50

## Outdoor Conventional Position

- Master 97.00 and above
- Expert 94.00 to 96.99
- Sharpshooter 91.00 to 93.99
- Marksman below 91.00

## Indoor Conventional Position

- Master 98.00 and above
- Expert 96.50 to 97.99
- Sharpshooter 93.00 to 96.49
- Marksman below 93.00

## Indoor Metric Position

- Master 92.00 and above
- Expert 89.00 to 91.99
- Sharpshooter 86.00 to 88.99
- Marksman below 86.00

## Outdoor Metric Position

- Master 89.00 and above
- Expert 86.00 to 88.99
- Sharpshooter 83.00 to 85.99
- Marksman below 83.00

# Using your Temporary Scorebook

- Always keep your temporary scorebook(s) up to date.
- Always keep your temporary scorebook with your equipment or in your shooting diary (also with your equipment).
- Be ready to present your temporary scorebook when you register for a match.

# Official Classification Card

Once you receive an Official Classification Card for a particular discipline (i.e., Outdoor Conventional Prone), you no longer need to track your classification yourself in a Temporary Scorebook.

- Always keep your Classification Cards with your equipment or in your shooting diary (also with your equipment).
- Be ready to present your Classification Card when you register for a match.

If you are not an NRA member, use the number on your Classification Card as your NRA number when entering matches. (This will ensure your scores are properly allocated to the correct person.)

If you didn't receive a Temporary Scorebook at your match, feel free to print out the following slides and use them instead.
